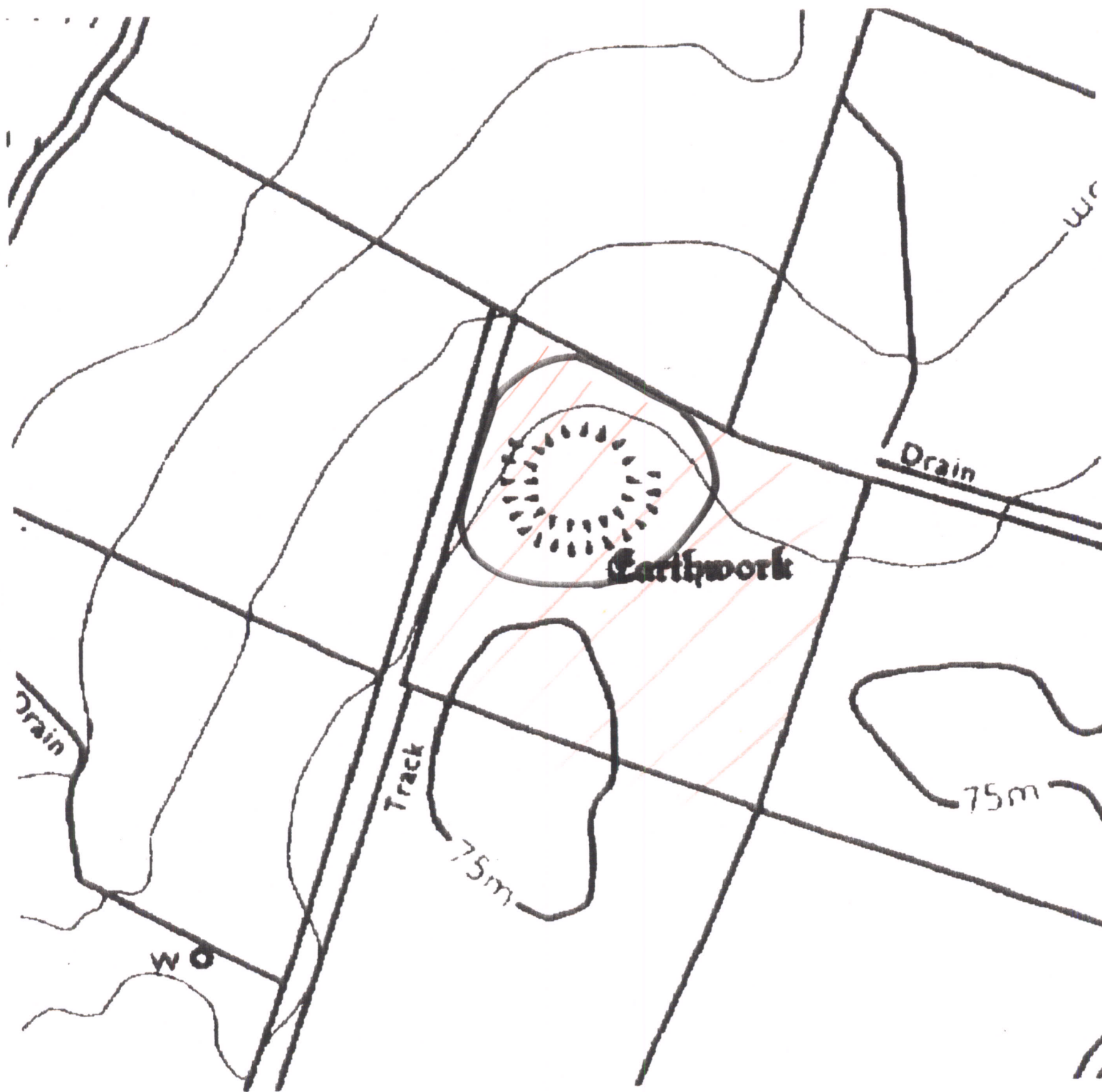

Set up in an elevated position - the site consists of a raised central area surrounded by a half crescent depression.
