DESCRIPTION....Possible deserted settlement site which includes a possible building platform. RPS August 2001; A raised rectilinear platform some 10m due west of a raised earthwork enclosure. The platform measures 10m x 9m and is 0.45m in height. It is thought to be a building platform. The associated enclosure is sub-circular and measures c. 42m N-S x 46m. No other features were noted in the vicinity of the given grid reference. However, there is an earthwork some 100m or so due east up the hill towards the farmhouse (Digital photo DCP 100-3036), which measures 10m N-S x 5m E-W x 0.35m high which looks very much like a platform (NGR SN0427225761).
