

The siting of St Bonifas Chapel at SN3991 1977 by the O.S. is in line with its described position in R.C.A.M. But it must be stated that there can be no certainty that this is the actual position. Another theory is that it stood close to Wainiyo Farm c SN240220 which has now been built over by the Wainiyo Summit housing estate.

The remains of an ecclesiastical structure at SN3991 1977 has in tradition also been called EGWYS LLANORDDU, but no explanation for this has been forthcoming.

The font is described as having four equidistant handles or ears was found in the area of the Rooyal Oak Inn at the junction of Job's Well Road also erroneously records it as having come from Prince Edward's Chapel.
