

The confusion by RCAM (and thus the OS) between "St John's Chapel" and "Capel Ifan" has its root cause lost in history.

There seems to be no evidence to connect "St John" with "Capel Ifan" (or EVAN).

The only evidence that remains to tell of the existence is the name "CAPEL EVAN ROAD" and fields. There are no visible remains and much of the area is covered by modern development.

The only St John's Chapel (apart from the modern church) known was that part of the Priory of St John which was demolished in the 19th cent. (see TCAS Vol 12 p 2)

Probably monastic lands of St John's Priory.
