

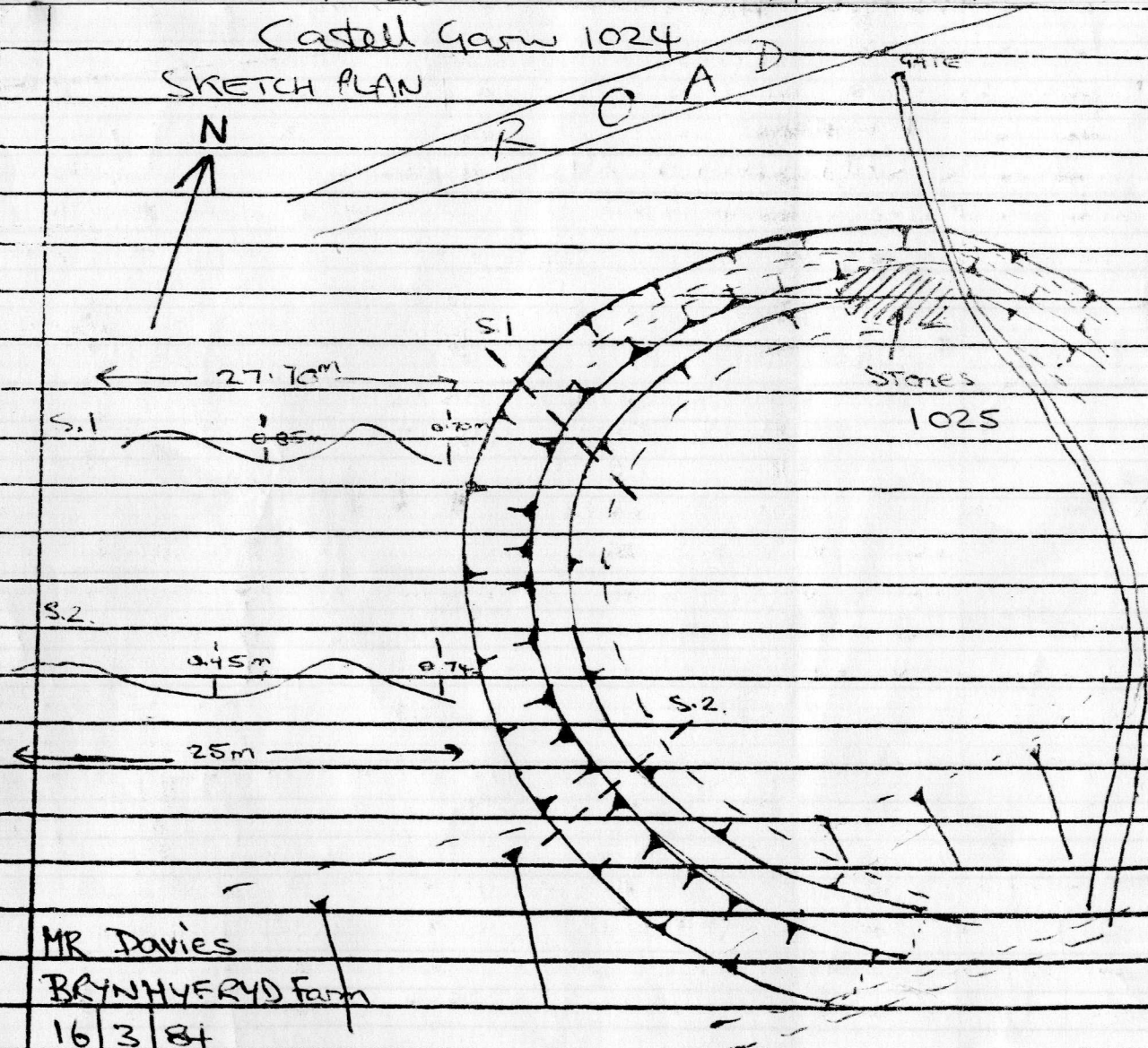
Castell Garw

Remains of a large roughly oval shaped enclosure which lies on a gently sloping field, apart from the extreme southern part of the site where it falls as a steep scarp. The site consists of a single bank relatively well preserved, standing up to a height of 0.75m, and a ditch, which is partly silted up in places, but has a depth of 0.95m in places. There is a collection of stones which can be seen on the NE of the enclosure which may be all that remain of the (burial chamber 1025)
