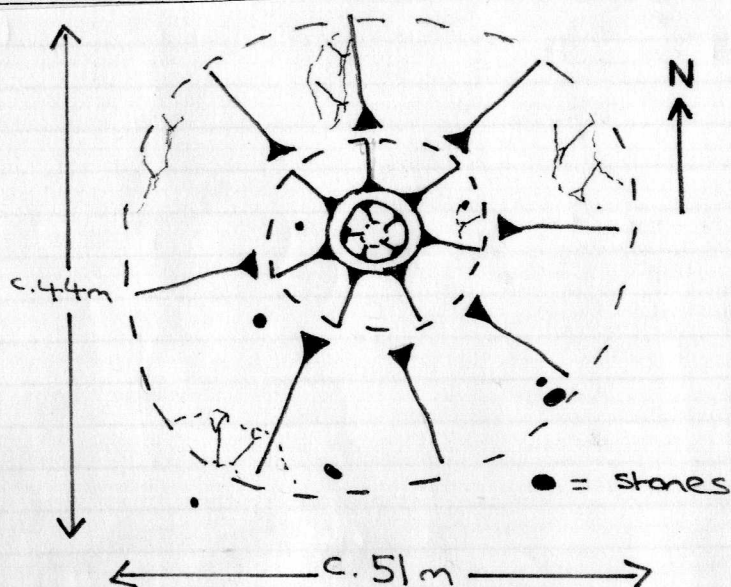


The mutilated remains of a large round barrow, situated in a relatively flat pasture field on Precelly farm. It measures 44m - 51 metres in diameter, and stands up to a height of c. 2.5 metres.

Several mutilations occur on the mound especially in its summit where there is a depression 5 metres in diameter, 0.3-4 metres deep, elsewhere the mutilations, could be due to animal breeding. 5 stones show up through the surface of the mound, three of these being of white quartz.
