Clydey Church and Churchyard 3 Inscribed Stones

(1) The SOLINI stone, formerly built into the church wall near the east entrance and now placed inside the church, is a rude pillar on which appear in debased Latin capitals SOLINI FILIUS VENDONI (2)

ETTERNI stone built into the north wall of the churchyard as a post for a sun-dial, inscribed in debased Latin capitals ETTERN FILI VICTOR and in Ogam ETTERN VICTOR. A rude pillar stone. (3) The DOBITACI FILIUS EVOLENG, in Ogams DOVOTACOS or DOBLATACEAS. A rude pillar with a cross on it.
