The camp is in a sloping field looking south-west, just above a ravine. There is a modern hedge to north-east. The top of the vallum has been levelled to a great extent, but can still be traced right round. There are said to be remains of a building on the east side in a hollow, but owing to the thick growth they could not be traced. From the hedge to edge of ditch is 74 yards; across widest part, at right angles to this line, 64 yards. Ancient weapons were found here in 1868. We could not obtain knowledge as to their nature or whereabouts.
