

"During the drainage operations in March [1875] a beam of oak twelve feet long and a foot square, with a morticed hole, and a smaller piece also morticed, were found 6 ft below the surface of the street, near the Old King George Tavern, King St. The cutting showed beneath the present surface about four feet of made soil under which the old surface of the street appeared to lie."
