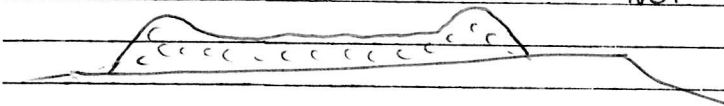


A Ring cairn composed almost entirely of quartz boulders and stones, the interstices filled with earth. Occupying a ridge-top position. This feature had no apparent outlying ditch and seemed to rest on a natural peak in the ground. It measures c. 18m in diameter and c. 0.6m - 0.8m in height. The outer edge is higher than the interior, although this is not a smooth surface.
