

- 77 No. 1 Gelliswick Mansion 10503
- In 1554 Rowland Meyrick, LL.D., married Catherine, daughter of Owen Barret of Gelliswick. He subsequently became Bishop of Bangor and founded the Meyrick family. He christened his eldest son Gelly.
- This place is also said to have been the cradle of the Pembroke-shire Allens. George Owen speaks of a cunnigar, or rabbit warren, here. Owen's Pembrokeshire, 571.

Built c 1725 by Allen family, the older house of Barrets forming the service wing. Upstanding bays, 3 full height storeys on raised cellars but single pile staircase in projecting rear wing. Sold to Esso Petroleum, who demolished it in 1980.
