


Evidence from AP's

Ridge + Furrow observed in field directly south of Art college. Half of the original field has been built on by the Art college. However, the ridge + furrow in the lower part of the field appeared to finish below a slight bank 3m below the fence line, but this effect has been caused by the foundations of the Art college buildings - on the AP's the Ridge + Furrow clearly goes to the top of the field.

Altogether there are 11 lines of ridge + furrow, running in a NW → SE direction. They are in a good condition apart from where slightly damaged by a track running across the southern part of the field. All are approx 3m wide and .75m high (from bottom of furrow → top of ridge).

There are slight surface irregularities in the SW corner of the field, but these are not visible on the AP's and are probably dumping from where the council houses have been built.
