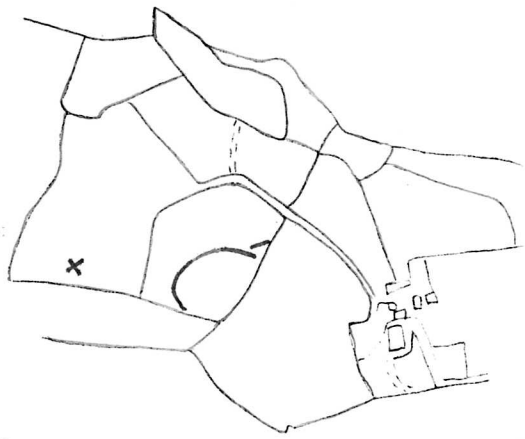

Mr Smith of Towry Castle Farm said that JF Jones had seen a 'Roman Encampment' on AP's and had shown him where it was. This was in the field to the north-west of the field mentioned above.	Mr Smith Towry Castle Farm (from JF Jones)
We inspected both of these fields carefully. Both are under pasture and not regularly ploughed, both incorporate plateaux and hill slopes and both have a good view of the Towry Valley + ^{steep} valley to south.
