

COMMENT

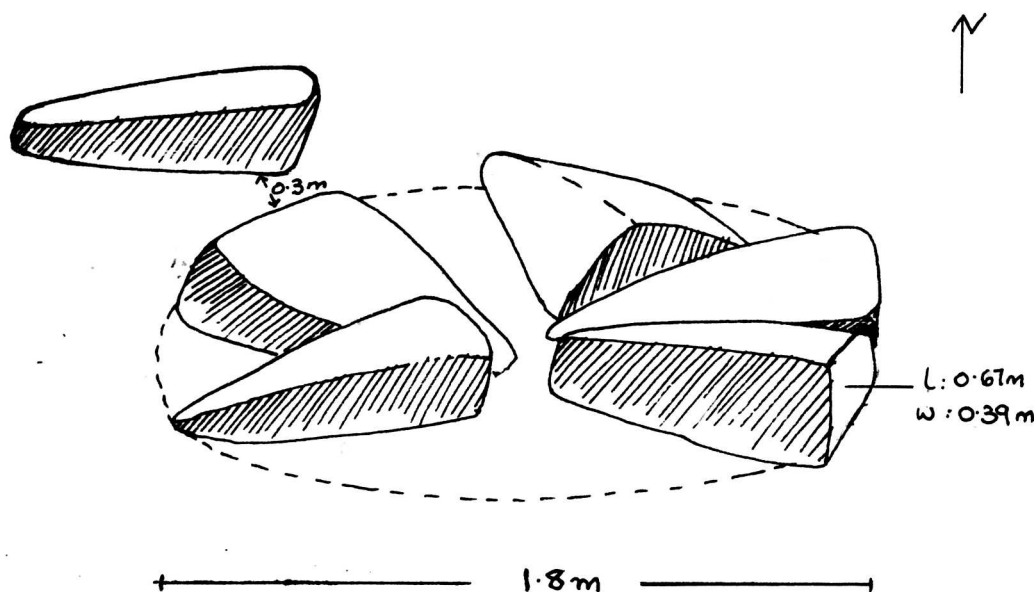
Group of 6 worked stones of local limestone wedge shaped and of similar dimensions. Five stones are situated within a circular area of darker soil 1.8m in diameter, the sixth stone lying about 0.3m away to the N. west among some young trees.

Mr Evans has been told that all the stones were once arranged within the circle, pointing in towards the centre, and that they had been covered over by an earthen mound.
