The field has no relevant name ③

The site is situated in the field directly north-west of the farm of Blaentfynhoman. It lies on the 110m contour just below the top of the slope which is now occupied by the main road through Llangynin village. It occupies a commanding position on an east facing slope with good views to north, east + south. From the AP's ① the site covers an area of some 0.69 Ha. The field is under pasture for cattle + was ploughed, for the first time within living memory, last year. Nothing unusual was noticed by Mr Morris and no finds were made. There are slight traces of this enclosure on the south and east side where a semicircular scarp is present. However, there is barely enough remaining to photograph or survey.
