This camp is situated about 1/3rd of a mile as the crow flies from the church. It is almost circular in shape, but the hedge cuts off a portion of it. It measures in diameter 34 yards, and is surrounded by a low but well defined bank and ditch, except the small section where the camp is cut into by the hedge, on the south side of the camp. The bank is about 5 ft high from the bottom of the ditch and outside of the ditch there are traces of another bank. The lowness of the banks suggests that the site has been ploughed, but at present it is covered with furze and other growth. There is no trace of any portion of the camp on the other side of the fence in question, so far as could be seen, but one of the fields was in standing grain, so that I could not be certain. The camp is in a commanding position.
