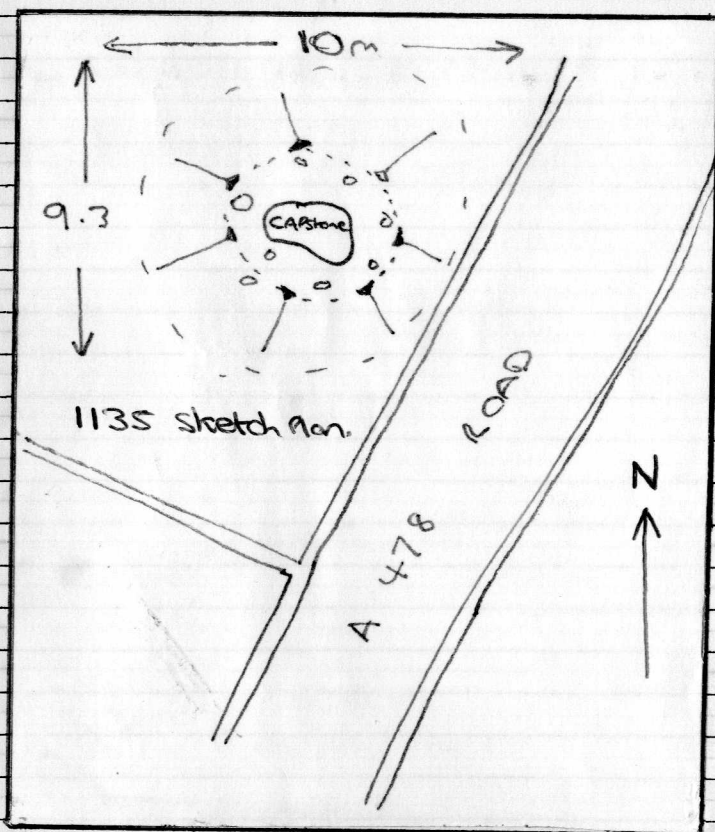

The capstone of this cromlech is lying flat on the ground; it is about 8 ft by 5 ft and its length points north-west. The uprights appear to have been taken away. There are some smaller stones under the capstone. There is a fine view to the north-west.

### CARN BESI - Burial chamber.

The much mutilated remains of a cromlech situated in the SE corner of a large Pasture Field, next to the A478, Cardigan to Talybont Road.

The site consists of a fallen capstone 2.4m by 1.35 metres sitting on top of a stone & turf covered mound c. 10 metres in diameter 0.5m high. The uprights have been removed.
