St. David's Church 1174, 5318

The church has been restored. There is a very pretty little square stone font, a silver chalice inscribed IGLH BRIDELL, 1687, a pewter paten MI. In the churchyard are some handsome yew trees, and the Nettasagri stone, a rude pillar on which is inscribed a cross, and the following in Ogams, NETTASAGRI MAQUI MUCOI BRECI. The gift of the living is vested in the freeholders of the parish.
