Spur of a hill cut off by a very strong foss, protected on the outer side by a deep declivity, perhaps artificially scarped. On top a roughly levelled plateau measuring 100 paces by 40. The soil from the foss is piled up as a bank on the plateau and a piece of natural rock acts as a sort of low keep.
