

COMMENT

A much ploughed out bivallate enclosure on a pasture field gently sloping to the SW. At the bottom of the slope the gradient becomes much more steep and would have formed an effective natural defence. The site commands a good view of the Taf valley. The banks visible were extremely low - in fact only visible from certain angles. Very little would show up in a photograph. Perhaps in other light more banks might show up than shown in the sketch below.

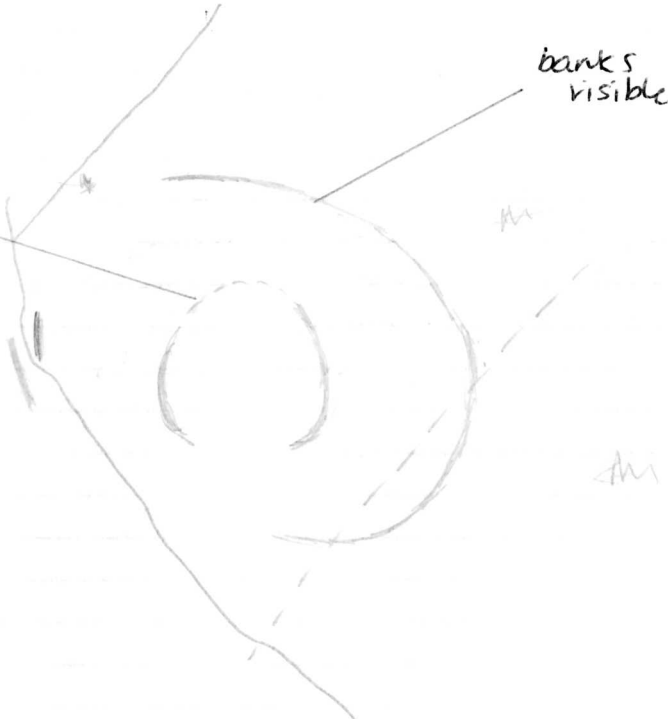
