9. (PRN 1873) ? RING CAIRN; SETTLEMENT. SN 76788766. Bryny Beddan. Fig. 3. (see also sites 35-39). Situated on a slight rocky eminence lie the remains of a D-shaped feature some 12 m long by 7 m wide, which though not circular

has much in common with ring cairns. Two wells of fieldstone run up to and merge with this feature on its western side. This site is located only a couple of metres below the maximum height of the reservoir; all the peat has been eroded, and the site is beginning to disintegrate. The eastern side of the site and lengths of the fieldwalls are obscured by "beach shingle".
