<p>24. Llain Wen (fig. 12; surveyed 1978) SN 69 SE</p> <p>Two small cairns lying at c. 300 m OD on moderately sloping ground and separated by a distance of 5.0 m. The NW cairn is an oval mound of consolidated stones and measures 6.0 m (NW-SE) \times 4.0 m with a height of 0.3 m. On the W side are four small earthfast quartz boulders suggesting a revetment kerb. Similar boulders lie about in the vicinity. The neighbouring cairn, on the SE, shows no clear evidence of kerbing. At its centre is an open cist. The site is marked on Gogerddan Estate Map (National Library of Wales No. 37.9) as 'stones' and lying along a line of the old farm boundary.</p>	<p>6910 9229</p>
