Manian Fawr

Inscribed Cross 1220

The foldyard gate at Manian Fawr is hung on a somewhat elaborate stone. Crosses, dots and triangles form a very unusual pattern thereon. It is apparently an early stone, although on one edge B.W.1698 is scratched. The stone somewhat resembles a fragment in St. Dogmael's Abbey, but is a stone of a different kind. There is a tradition that this stone in days gone by was used as a foot-bridge near the entrance to St. Dogmael's Vicarage.
