

Visited by J H Williams, 26/4/77.

Largely as described (1). Site consists of a circular depression on gently sloping ground overlooking the steep scarps of a valley. The sides of the hollow slope downward all around ^{circumference} ~~circumference~~ i.e. the site doesn't take the form of a levelled platform. A bank is traceable on the uphill side, particularly on the NE, but is almost ploughed out. There is a very doubtful linear bank running off to the NE from the centre of this uphill bank.

Site is considerably plough reduced but further ploughing will only be associated with reseedling.
