

The parish school is built in the camp, which slopes to the south, where there is a natural defence of cliff with the Angof at the foot. It measures about 150 yards by 80 yards. There is a deep dyke all round until it reaches the cliff on either side. The bank is in places 25 feet high.

Large ringwork castle bank breached (recently) on western side in the construction of a drive to the school house.

Section trowelled but no defence or revetment traces found. Bank of shale.
