For the church see Arch. Camb. V, xv, 281. There is a squat late Perpendicular tower; the old Norman font has been recovered and is now in the churchyard. On the top of the strong battlemented tower a stone has on it "J.P.W.T., 1779". Ambleston, Rinaston and Woodstock all belonged to the Preceptory of Slebech. The 3 manors of those names were held of Wiston. Owen's Pembrokeshire I, 368.
