At the spot marked by the uppermost symbol for very many years lay a great anchor. It has now been removed to the spot marked by the lower symbol. The shank is 20 feet long, and about 30 ins thick, though much has peeled off in rust; the flukes measure 14 feet on the outside circumference, and the ring is big enough for a man to crawl through. Tradition says it is a relic of the Spanish Armada; but even if this be granted, how did it get to Hoaten?
