Porth Lisky on Lleschi. Fenton (p. 119) assumes Lisky to be an invader who landed here. By an excerpt from Ric. James's MSS in Bodleian Library the inhabitants of Villa Porthlysky, by their tenure were to take charge of malefactors in the Bishop's prison (Fenton, p. 112). Leschi is named in the (Anglia Sacra, II, 636) Life of St. David, as having defeated and put to death the tyrant Boia, of Clegyr Boia.
