- The Teivy runs over boulders and rock ridges which formed the
- Llechryd or Stonyford, where in 1087 Rhys ap Tewdwr crushed Cadwgan
- Madog and Rhiryd, sons of Bleddyn ab Cynvyn, Prince of Gwynedd.
- Madog and Rhiryd were slain and Cadwgan escaped with difficulty.
- This battle has been located by Welsh historians in Radnor, but
- Fenton pretty clearly proves that it took place at Llechryd.
