The references (by Mr. Henry Owen) are - Trefclement (Owen's Penbrokeshire, p. 350 quoting from the Black Book of St. David's) Llether Triglemes (in Patent Rolls 12, Car. I, part 1); Villa Clementis (in the Cartulary of St. David's and various charters). Geoffrey Clement is mentioned in the Cartulary as witness to a deed in 1309; he had a grant of land from EdwardI in 1290. Maud, the daughter of his descendant, John Clement, Lord of Tregaron, married John Wogan of Wiston. This place-name probably came from this family.
