A field system possibly contemporary with Blaen Cothi, perhaps earlier. The banks all attain a height of approximately 0.4-0.6m and are approximately 0.7m wide. They are chiefly earth built and somewhat eroded. In cross section they form a Δ shape and have clearly defined layers of soil within them ranging from orangey/brown on the outside to humic black material at the centre. Some of the boundaries lie beneath a track, and lead into the marshy area. Possibly they represent field boundaries where peat cutting was practised in this area where they lay on the hillside they clearly demarcate the edges of fields, chiefly of rectangular shape. On the upper sketches, ditches may be observed beside the banks.

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
