The Church of St. Michael was restored in 1875. There is a stone pillar on the south of the altar and a stone shelf on the south thereof, and a square recess on the south chancel wall. The font is new, but the piscina and the steps of the rood loft remain. The chancel is divided from the nave by upright stone slabs. Part of the churchyard cross is in the yard.
