This cromlech is, or rather was, at Prysc, not at Temple Druid. It stood, so it is said, in the farmyard of Prysc, but was taken down. One man told us it was sunk in a hole in the yard. For its removal see Arch. Camb. V, xiii, 134. In a field adjoining and south-east of Prysc homestead, there is a standing stone about 7 feet high, which may have been the upright of a cromlech. Temple Druid house was built as a hunting box by Barrington Price early in the last century.
