There are traces of two buildings here, of which only the foundation remain. There are in a three-cornered enclosure, and the one on the south-western side measures about 12 yards square. About 5 yards to the north-east of this there are the foundations of another building measuring about 4 yards by 6 yards. There are a number of tombstones in the enclosure, the oldest we could find being the death of William James in 1797, and the latest the death of Griffith Phillip of Hendre who died in 1840. This last stone is an upright stone in the middle of the foundation first referred to, so that the building in which it is situated must have been disused at that date.
