A large circular camp (roughly 150 yards by 124) with an outwork on the west side. The east side is defended by a deep ditch cut in the live rock; the remainder by a bank, the material having been taken from the interior, making the camping ground level. The outwork is on a lower level than the camp, 80 yards by 40, defended by a bank, the material taken from the outside. It is a rough rectangular oblong. The entrance to the camp was through the outwork.
