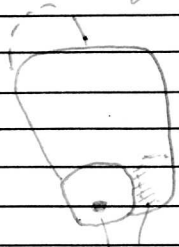


## COMMENT

## AUTHORITY

This is a rare example of an unenclosed settlement on relatively low land showing as a cropmark during the 1984 drought. It seems to comprise a hut circle with an adjoining annex to one side, with possibly an addition beyond (sketch). The main problem is locating its precise position and although I have given an NGR the site may best be considered as a marginal entry. There are insufficient reference points in the photo to accurately locate the site, although a site visit would be able to confirm the location.

In a field immediately SE of the abandoned settlements of Cwm Llanedrez and Ffos-y-ffwrn is a cropmark of an unenclosed or weakly enclosed settlement. The interior includes a possible hut to one side and rich dark positive cropmarks.
