

Both the fields in which this earthwork lies were ~~mappe~~ reclaimed by stone clearance, ploughing & reseeded in 1980.

Whereas the bank, in the W field survives largely as described and planned by the OS* (Auth 1) the NE quadrant, within the E field, has been demolished along with the modern boundary bank at this point, and only the slightest traces of its inner edge survive, and are largely overlain by boulders from the stone clearance.

In the W field the bank survives to a height of c 50cm (est). Its stony composition is very evident and is emphasised by the ditch grass & bracken growing on it.
