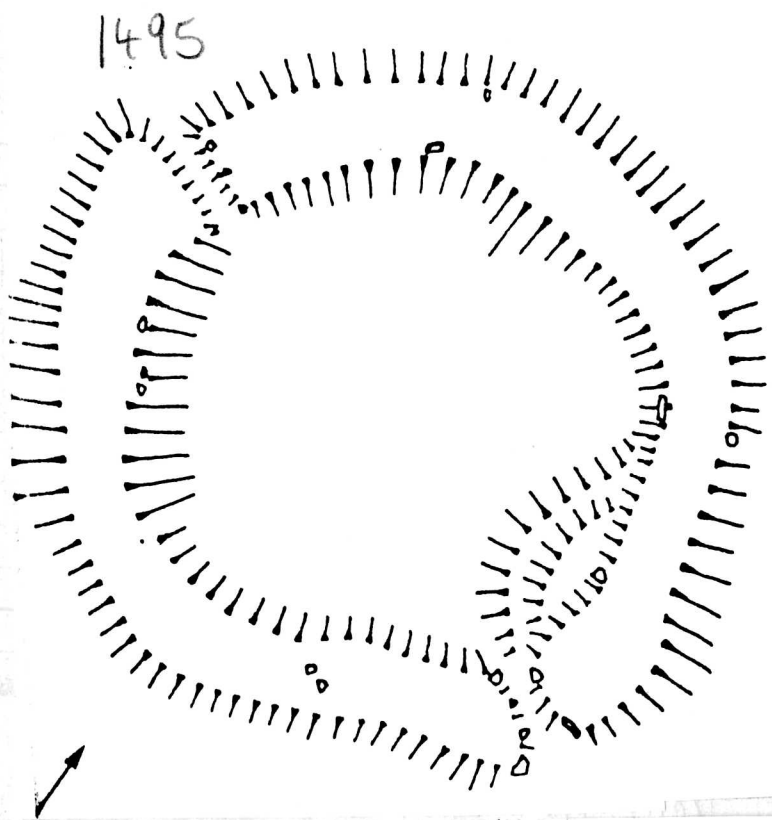

The circle marked on the map lying about north of Carn Edward seems to be a small camp, of which the walls were composed of small stones and sods, rather than the remains of a dwelling. It is an almost perfect circle, and measures about 21 yards in diameter. There is another circle of a similar type a little to the north-north-west of the other. Its diameter is 9 yds. These are all the circles to be found in the locality, but there are very many stones scattered over the land which suggest circles. It does not seem that they are artificial.
