AUTHORITY

In a field on the S. side of Cuttemartin village are a series of v. clear earthworks. The most distinct of these are two hollow ways, one running N-S, the other SE-NW. At the N. end of the field are at least two clear earthwork platforms and further earthworks - but very unclear - exist on the E. side of the field; these may be building foundations. There is also a small quarry pit on the E. side of the field.

The E-W hollow-way is shown in use on a map of 1780, as it is the bank running N-S down the field. The platforms at the N. edge of the field appear to be the rear of prototypes - the houses fronted the lane to the N. The N-S. hollow-way is not shown.
