

19 No. 10 Llys-y-defaid Old Road 1524

A portion of the VIA FLANDRICA. Llys-y-defaid (Sheep's Court)
See Fenton, p. 345.

21 No. 7 Via Flandrica Old road 1524

This ancient roadway is well marked at this point. (Kilkiffeth)

22 No. 3 Via Flandrica Old Road 1524

This road bore several names - VIA FLANDRICA, FFORDD Y LLADRON
(Thieves' Way) YR HEN FFORDD, and FFORDD HELEN - Fenton, p. 32.

24 No. 1 Preselly Disused Track 1524

Nowhere in the county of Pembroke can this old roadway be followed to better advantage. It is known by various names - VIA JULIA, VIA FLANDRICA, and PILGRIM'S WAY - and consists hereabouts of a raised bank about 10 feet wide with indications of a ditch on either side. It will be observed that the map-maker has marked at intervals, "hole", "picket and pile of stones". The conclusion we arrived at respecting these was that the holes were of comparatively recent construction, and made for the purpose of cutting turf to drive off along the old track, but that they had been kept open and enlarged by the mountain sheep getting in to scratch themselves and shelter from sun and wind. With regard to the piles of stones and "pickets" it seems as if the earthen bank which formed the track had at some period been repaired with stone in considerable quantities, and that then the bank had again given way, and exposed the heaps of stones which had been used to mend it.

25 No. 1 Carn Meini Disused Track 1524

The so-called VIA JULIA, VIA FLANDRICA or FLEMING'S WAY runs across this quarter sheet, only very occasionally is it raised, but in most parts may be tracked as a line of grass running through heather showing that the tread of generations had so compressed the soil as to make it incapable of growing heath. The stones and holes marked by the map-maker do not appear to be of consequence.

26 No. 8 Rhoscoch Old Road 1524

The old way known as FFORDD FFLEMING is very clearly to be seen at this point, the modern highway having been turned to avoid a hill.

30 No. 3 Waun-y-Beddau Ancient Road 1524

Site of the VIA FLANDRICA

30 No. 13 Penberry Ancient Road 1524

The VIA FLANDRICA passed through this field; the hedge of the field was extended to present road by the late Mr. D. Williams, Penberry, about 60 years ago.

32 No. 5 Road 1524

Ancient Road. This is the road commonly known as the Flemings' Way.

33 No. 8 Ancient Road 1524

A portion of the VIA FLANDRICA.

34 No. 5 Lochturffin Roman road 1524

There is no reason, apparently, for thinking this to be a Roman road but it is a very ancient way

35 No. 15 Road So-called Roman Road 1524

A portion of the Via Julia.

38 No. 2 Via Flandrica Ancient Road 1524

The present road is carried along the line of the Flemings' Way.
