This camp, roughly estimated, is about $1\frac{1}{2}$ acres in area within its vallum. It is protected on 3 sides naturally by steep hills, and is defended on the land side by a foss and wall which appears to have been dry built. It is well situated for defence. It may possibly have been the fastness of DAFYDD DDU, who gave battle to the Normans at Morville (Fenton, pp. 568-9). An adjacent farm is called Caerwen, and this may have been taken from the name of the camp.
