Kilkiffeth Mountain

If the objects here marked tumuli are correctly described, they have been completely "turned inside out". They more resemble overgrown hut circles than tumuli. The northern work is 16 yd across, hollow to a depth of about 4 ft, and 15 large stones are to be seen forming the circle. Bullrushes grow in the centre. The southern work has very similar characteristics, but it is 22 yds in diameter and the circle is composed of smaller stones.

Classed as RING rather than ROUND barrow as all descriptions seem to agree on physical form, & this appears more than the normal "central depression" exhibited by 1542.
