On this site there is a depression 10 yds long by 3 yds wide, and adjoining and running parallel to it is a second depression of about 3 yds wide. These seem to be the foundations of the chapel, as there are traces of stonework on the south side of the depression. There is no well, but a small stream of water flows along the south-east side. The site is surrounded by some rough land, which may have formed a small churchyard, but I could find no evidence of graves. For the pilgrimage chapels in this district see Owen's Pembrokeshire I, 509.
