


COMMENT

AUTHORITY

The limekiln lies on the limit of the mudflats at the point where the beach rises up to form the land surface. It is built up against this edge which is heavily overgrown with gorse and bushes. At low tide the base is submerged. It consists of two chambers, back to back, one to the west which is almost intact, one to the east which is ruined and overgrown. It is constructed of a mixture of cut stone and waterworn boulders in mortar and an ~~large~~ area of loose stone around the base is rubble from the structure.
