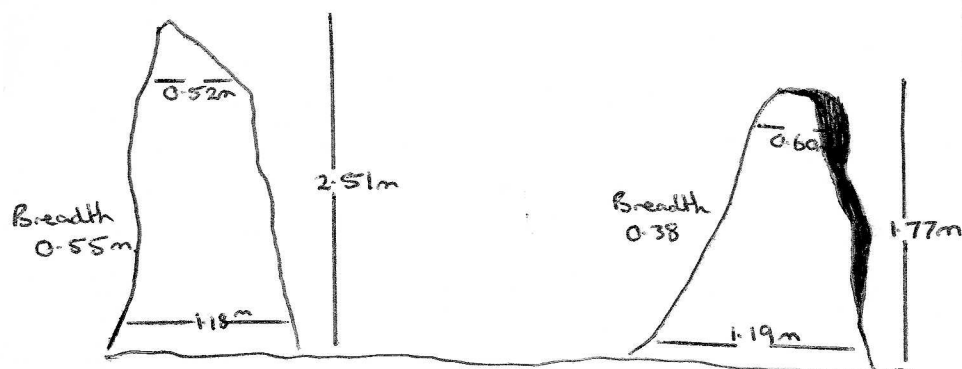


Pair of standing stones in a field

PORTAL DOLMEN IS UNCHANGED. GROUND IS
NOT BADLY CUT UP BY CATTLE (FIELD USED AS
PASTURE FOR DAIRY HERD). THE CAPSTONE(?) OF
RUINED BURIAL CHAMBER IS SITUATED IN THE
SOUTH-EASTERN CORNER OF THE FIELD AT
NGR 4330 0996 - HAS APPEARANCE OF NATURALLY
PLACED BOULDER 9 FEET 6 INCHES LONG, 4 FEET
6 INCHES BROAD AND 2 FEET THICK, THOUGH THE
ABSENCE OF OTHER LARGE STONES IN VICINITY
ITS DOCUMENTARY ORIGIN.
