## AUTHORITY

The existence of a furnace near Blackpool  
Forge is inferred from the following evidence:

1. Robert Moron (who obtained a lease of the  
iron forge at Blackpool) was also entitled to  
take wood from Coniston Wood, Pickle Wood,  
Toch Wood and "the other woods... within  
a radius of 4 miles of the forge". The lessee  
was also given the right to "charcoal or coke  
the wood" on the premises.
