


**COMMENT** Caerau Clwydwr is a promontory fort defended on the NW & SE sides by steep natural slopes and on the NE & SW sides by a bank & ditch.

## AUTHORITY

The SW side has an entrance gap at the eastern end which has been widened recently and a surface of loose chippings laid by the farm. The bank is overgrown with trees and blackthorn. On the NE side the bank is best preserved at the western end with a height of ~ 1.8m.

Towards the southern end of the fort there is a slight cross bank and a discolouration in the grain. The farmer said that he had cleared some trees from here in 1982. No future work planned.
