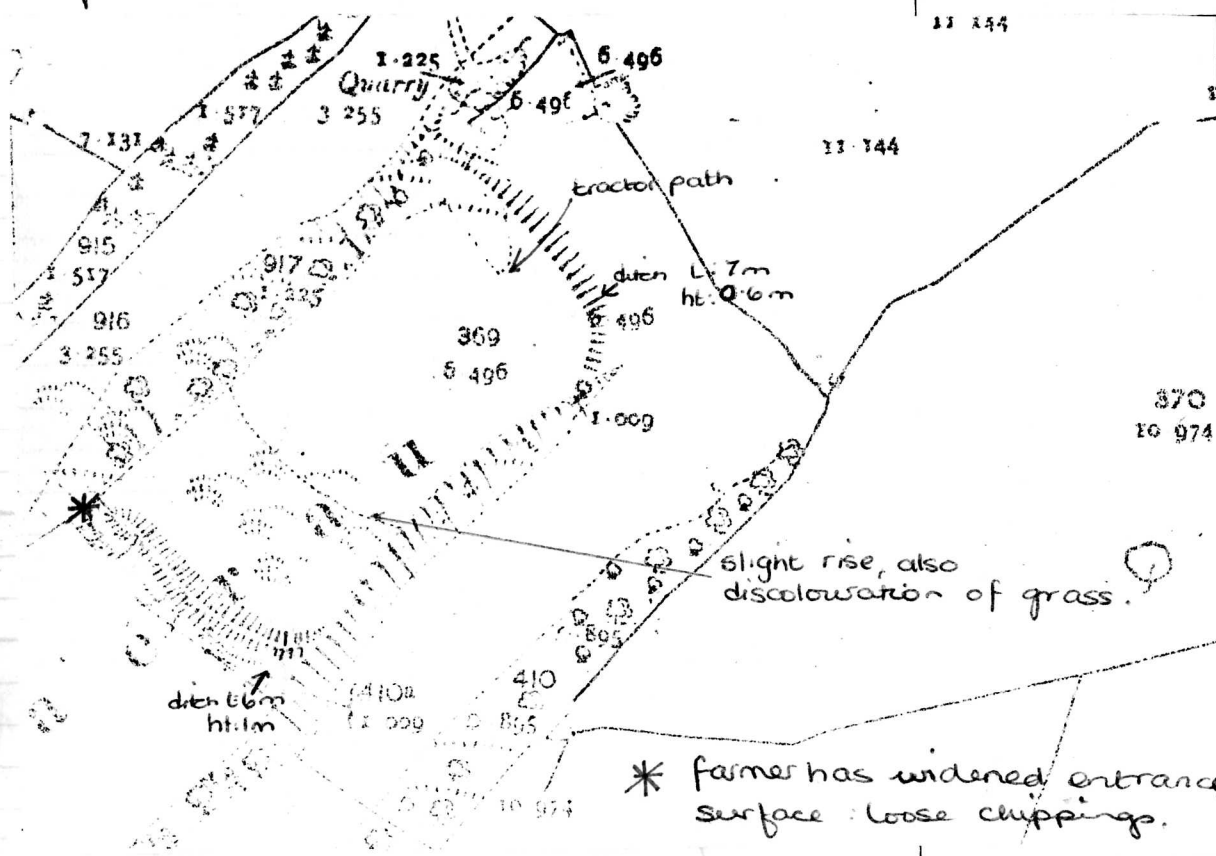


The SW side has an entrance gap at the eastern end which has been widened recently and a surface of loose chippings laid by the farmer. The bank is overgrown with trees and blackthorn. On the NE side the bank is best preserved at the western end with a height of $\sim 1.8\text{m}$.

Towards the southern end of the fort there is a slight cross bank and a discolouration in the grass. The farmer said that he had cleared some trees from here in 1982. No future work planned.
