


Standing stone now recumbent

"A stone standing above ground to the  
height of 10 feet, in a field called 'Parc Garreg Lwyd'.  
It is 68" broad and 18" thick at the base, and has  
a somewhat pointed end. Its flat side faces  
north".

"a recumbent slab, eleven feet in length, 68"  
wide, and 22" thick .... it was upright, but  
since that date the <sup>land</sup> owner has had to dig  
beneath the maen hir ..... It is reported that

The stone has : been recumbent since  
some time between 1913 and 1931, the  
position from RCAHM coordinates seems  
to be the same position as the OS mark  
on the 1964 6" OS map SN43 NW
