PONT LLADRON - The Robbers' Bridge. In days gone by there was a saying common to the Englishry and Welshery of Pembrokeshire: "All thieves through Trefgarn" for the two nationalities were connected by this pass, and between its precipitous rocks loot was continually passing, sometimes commandeered from the north (or Welsh side) sometimes from the south (or English).
